

ST. MICHAEL'S ACADEMY

SUMMER CAMPS 2019

General Info: Camps are open to St. Michael's students and to students in the surrounding communities. Camps are offered for a variety of ages: preschool through 5th grade. Camps are intended for the grade level that the child will be entering in the fall of 2019.

Registration Deadline: A non-refundable registration fee of \$25 is required for each child in each camp at the time of registration in order to hold your child's space. Registration fees will only be refunded if the Academy is unable to provide the camp due to low enrollment. In some cases, camps may be combined if there is low enrollment.

Parents will have up until 2 weeks (14 days) before any camp to pay the balance of the camp fees (and any care fees.) This will enable us to ensure that we are properly staffed and have purchased enough supplies for every camper. Balances not paid by this date will result in forfeiture of your child's spot in camp.

The school will purchase all craft materials. **NOTE:** There is a sibling discount of 15% for the first sibling and 20% for all others. This discount is for camp only (not care programs). \$25 per child will still be due at registration.

Before care, Aftercare, Extended Care:

- 7:00-9:00 Before Care COST: \$40/week
- 12:00/4:00 Preschool/Kindergarten After Care COST: \$80/week
- 2:00/4:00 Elementary After Care COST: \$40.00/ week
- 4:00-6:00 Extended Care COST: \$50/week

Care fees are collected for the full week, not by the day or the hour. Proration is not available. Camp drop off begins at 9:00 a.m. and pick up begins at 12:00 p.m. (or 2:00 p.m. for Elementary campers). Children not picked up within 10 minutes of the end of camp will be put in After Care and parents will be charged \$10/hr or partial-hour. Children not picked up by 4:00 will be put in Extended care and parents will be charged \$15/hr or partial-hour. Children not picked up by 6:00 p.m. will be charged a \$25 fee PLUS \$1/minute after 6:00 p.m.

Elementary students will participate in at least three field trips per a week, including Regal Cinemas and Larry Weeks Pool. All preschool and elementary camp supplies and field trips are covered by camp fees.

Campers should bring:

- All campers should bring a nut-free snack daily
- All campers bring water bottles (labeled with name)
- All campers wear sunscreen and bug spray (we can reapply with proper documentation)
- All campers staying for Extended Care should bring an additional nut-free snack daily
- Elementary campers bring a lunch daily (labeled with name)

Week 1 – June 10-14

- **Preschool/Kind Camp: MAD SCIENTIST-** Come join us as we take a fun, hands-on approach to science. We'll conduct experiments, create a few (safe) explosions, and have a real BLAST!
- **Elementary Camp: Chemist** - Like mixing it up in the kitchen or creating your own concoctions? Explore the chemistry of cooking and making candy, mixing up the bounciest of bouncy balls, and how to write an invisible message.

Week 2 – June 17-21

- **Preschool/Kind Camp: BEACH-** Frolic in the sand and surf! You'll visit the beaches of the world. There will be water play, seaside artwork, and more. Learn about all the different species that live in and around the water and why it is so important to help keep our beaches clean.
- **Elementary Camp: Environmental Scientist - Learn** what it takes to keep our soil from eroding, design a water filtration system, windmill, and providing water by digging a well in Africa! Scientists are needed to keep our earth clean and to protect our habitats.

Week 3 – June 24-28

- **Preschool/Kind Camp: PAINTING WITH PICASSO-** Get ready to get MESSY! We will be exploring different artists as well as discovering the use of various art materials. Who knows what amazing creations each budding artist will produce?
- **Elementary Camp – Designers and Artists** - Everything we use had to go through a design process. Even creating art takes elements of design! Come spend the week with designing toys, food packaging, treats for animals, and even make portraits using wacky materials!

Week 4 – July 1-5 (*NOTE: THIS IS A 4-DAY CAMP. THERE IS NO CAMP ON JULY 4. Prices are reduced accordingly.*)

- **Preschool/Kind Camp: (\$95.00) TRANSPORTATION:** From bicycles to space shuttles, discover the world of transportation!
- **Elementary Camp: (\$140.00): MEDICAL PROFESSION:** Have you ever wondered how your digestive system works or how a prosthetic hand is made? We will learn a few medical terms and wonders at this camp and even take a behind-the-scenes look at the hospital.

Week 5 – July 8-12

- **Preschool/Kind Camp: SPACE & STAR WARS-** We live in an amazing, vast, and beautiful universe! Join us on this exciting expedition into space, where you may even encounter some Star Wars characters along the way! FRIDAY: Dress up as your favorite character or astronaut!
- **Elementary Camp: Astronaut** - The universe is a curious place and larger than we could ever imagine! Come and explore it like a real astronaut with lessons on space transportation, astronaut food, designing a planet rover, and creating a parachute!

Week 6 – July 15-19

- **Preschool/Kind Camp: SAFARI:** Grab your binoculars - it's time to go on a safari! Join us as we travel across the African plains, learning all about the people and wildlife that call Africa home.
- **Elementary Camp: WILDLIFE SPECIALIST** - This week involves learning why wildlife specialists are so important! Children will learn about bee-friendly gardens, the science of keeping bears out of garbage cans, and designing homes for a declining hedgehog population.

Week 7 – July 22-26

- **Preschool/Kind Camp:** - Come find out how things work! Learn how to take apart and put together and have lots of fun!
- **Elementary Camp: Engineer** - Does your brain focus on numbers and solving problems? This engineering camp teaches children to solve building problems using science! Students will design a water slide, miniature golf course, and robots to help put out fires and stop pollution.

Week 8 – July 29-August 2

- **Preschool/Kind Camp:**
 - A: SPA-** Explore all things girly! We will learn manners, etiquette, get our nails done, and dress up galore! The highlight of our week will be a High Tea on Friday!
 - B: SUPERHERO-** Whether they're flying through the air, battling fires, or fighting the enemy, these real and fantastical heroes will thrill you! Come celebrate the classic comic book heroes, everyday heroes, and Biblical heroes that inspire us all.
- **Elementary Camp: Architecture** - Love building things out of Legos or blocks when you were little? This camp explores the world of architects and how they plan, design, and oversee the building of structures. Campers will build an island shelter, underwater building, and solve the problem of transporting goods across a river.

Week 9 – August 5-9

- **Preschool/Kind Camp: CIRCUS-** Campers will enjoy walking the tightrope, learning to juggle, and having all kinds of fun "clowning around."
- **Elementary Camp: SCIENTIST** - Learning what a scientist does can be so much fun! This camp week explores the careers of food and forensic scientists with experiments in strawberry DNA, whipping up ice cream, and crime scene investigations of missing pizza!

Week 10 – August 12-16

- **Preschool/Kind Camp: DINOSAUR DIG-** Come join us as we learn all about paleontology and study the different types of dinosaurs. We'll be making our own fossils and playing fun games like Footprint Search as we explore all things prehistoric!
- **Elementary Camp: Archaeologist** - This is the week for detectives and children who love to dig! Enjoy a week making a time capsule, designing artifacts, creating an archeological dig, and decoding Egyptian hieroglyphs!
